## Christ, the Light of the World

## John 8:1-11

Verse 1, Contrasted with 7:58, shows the poverty and humiliation of Christ. Matthew 8:20, 2 Corinthians 8:9

Verse 2, Early activity around the house of God. It brings help and blessings to followers. No respecter of persons.

Verses 3-11, Jesus is the friend of sinners. The bringing of the woman was to discredit Him before the people, verse 6.

Leviticus 20:10, Deuteronomy 22:22, if He ignored, they would accuse Him of compromising with sin.

If He condemned her what would become of His claim as friend and savior of sinners. John 3:17, Luke 19:10, 2 Samuel 14:13-14

Verse 5, Wicked men can quote scripture when they imagine that it will further their evil doing.

Sometimes they who quote scripture are more guilty than if they wouldn't. Matthew 7:3

Verse 6, The exposers exposed. Exodus 31:18, Chapter 7:19, Romans 2:1, 4:15, law worketh wrath.

Verse 7, They can't justify self, trying to hide behind sins of others. James 2:10, presence of Jesus reveals personal guilt.

Verse 88, Everybody is under Law or Grace, even now.

- 1. First table of testimony broken smashed to the ground
- 2. The second table was written, placed in the ark, under the blood sprinkled on the mercy seat. Exodus 40:20
  - a. Law would be established.
  - b. The shed blood of innocent victim would come between the law and condemned sinners.

Verse 9, Conviction often drives sinners away. Conviction is not salvation.

Verse 11, Salvation: verdict of grace, Romans 8:1, be done with sin. 2 Corinthians 5:17, Romans 6:12-13.
